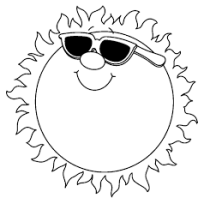

And now....here’s show week!

Monday, May 6 Tickets will go on sale in choir classes for \$3. Please get your tickets in advance so that you can go to the show of your choice. We usually sell out one or both! Tell your child if you want the 4:30 ticket or the 7:00 p.m. ticket. (Volunteers -photographer, locker decorations and chaperones) who receive free tickets should ask for them in advance.

Thursday, May 9 Students will ride over to NHS for this rehearsal. Please pick them up at Door 15.

6th grade: Door 15 (Backside of high school) by the pool parking lot.
7th Grade: Door 1 (front of the high school – teacher’s parking lot door).
8th grade Door 21 (Backside of high school) by the band parking lot.

***Knight Lights will stay until 6:30 p.m. and should be picked up at Door 15.**

Call time for all choir students will be 4:00 p.m. 7th and 8th graders will be warming up in the NHS Choir Room. 6th Graders will be warming up in the NHS Band Room. Students should wear their new t-shirts and blue jeans. No shorts, or capris, or skirts, will be allowed without permission from Mrs. A for individuals who need to alter the attire.

Auditorium Doors will open 45 minutes before each show. If we have any leftover tickets after the presale, they will be available at the ticket table.
